Requirements:

- 1. It is preferable that the application be submitted in electronic or typewritten form. The fillable application form can be found below. Please answer all questions in a thorough and detailed manner so that the review committee can learn as much as possible about each applicant.
- 2. The applicant should be a junior or senior ABA member in good standing, or a team purebred member or have completed a 2 year Berkshire project through FFA or 4-H programs. *One or both of your references should validate this membership/participation in his/her letter of recommendation.*
- 3. The applicant must be accepted into or currently enrolled in a 2 or 4 year accredited university, college, or certified program to be considered for scholarship.
- 4. The applicant **must** submit <u>2 letters of recommendation</u> from teachers, 4-H leaders, clergy, employers, etc. who knows the individual on a personal level, but is **NOT a relative**.
- 5. The payment will not be awarded until first semester transcript is received along with proof of enrollment into the next semester.
- 6. Recipients can only receive an American Berkshire Foundation scholarship once.
